GLOSSARIO DEL VINO

UVE ROSSÉ | ITALIAN RED GRAPES

AGLIANICO

A full-bodied red wine native to southern Italy. Shows firm tannins and concentrated red fruit flavors.

AMARONE

From the Veneto region. One of Italy's most unique and powerful reds, Made from dried, concentrated grapes (principally Corvina). Tempting notes of jam, cinnamon, and leather with a full, rich palate.

BARBERA

Originating in Piedmont, earthy with soft tannins and bright plush fruit. Aromas of dark berries and vanilla.

DOLCETTO

"Little sweet one" Dolcetto is at its best in the Piedmont region. Soft flavors of plush fruit and licorice with hints of violets.

MONTEPULCIANO

Originating in Abruzzo. Deep in color, Rustic and aromatic with notes of currants, blackberry, and spice.

NEBBIOLO

Native to Piedmont, stands shoulder to shoulder with Sangiovese as Italy's most noble grape. Known for its stealth power with notes of tar, dried cherries, and roses. Nebbiolo is the key grape in Barbaresco and Barolo, as well as the lesser known, but compelling Gattinara.

NEGROAMARO

Grown almost exclusively in Apulia, particularly in Salento. Very dark skinned grape with a blackberry nose. Rustic in character with an earthy bitterness.

NERELLO MASCALESE

Light bodied Sicilian red wine grown primarily on the slopes of Mount Etna. Taste profile often likened to Pinot Noir with explosive red fruit flavors that leads into spice notes of cinnamon and floral dried desert herbs.

NERO D'AVOLA

The red grape for which the island of Sicily is famous. Seductive aromas of red fruits and spice with a round smoky palate reminiscent of Syrah.

PRIMITIVO

Considered the predecessor Zinfandel, the pride of southern situated Apulia. Full-bodied and juicy with moderate acidity and rich, dark fruit.

SANGIOVESE

Italy's leading red grape with multiple expressions. Medium to full-bodied with aromas of black cherry, wood, smoke, and herbs. Plays a starring role in Chianiti, Brunello, Vino Nobile, and many Super Tuscans.

UVE BIANCHE | ITALIAN WHITE GRAPES

VERNACCIA

The white wine of Tuscany famous since The Renaissance and most commonly associated with the "Town of Towers" San Gimignano. Displaying aromas of dried pear with hints of lime and melon. Has a great ability to age up to a decade. Mentioned by Dante (Purgatorio XXIV) as leading to Pope Martin IV's gluttony, so enjoy responsibly!

MOSCATO D'ASTI

From Northern Italy's Piedmont region this lightly fizzy white wine contains delightfully pungent aromas of white peaches, fresh white blossoms, and bright citrus.

PINOT GRIGIO

Made from Pinot Gris grapes. Italy's most known and popular white wine; brightly acidic and dry with tropical fruit, and almond notes. At its best in the northern, cooler climates.

TREBBIANO

One of the most widely planted white grapes in Italy. Deftly balanced with flora notes and distinct minerality. A worthy partner to the Garganega grape in the Soave D.O.C.

VERMENTINO

A white typically associated with Liguria, but up and coming in Tuscany and Sardinia. Savory with herbal notes. Finishing with flavors reminiscent of the Mediterranean.
